Cross Country Events

On Thursday 23rd October 2014 we took our Y3/4 Squad and our Y5/6 Squad to two different Cross Country competitions.

Our Y3/4 pupils were taking part in the first Tendring Small Schools' Cluster Cross Country run at Wix Equestrian Centre. There were six schools participating and each school could have 3 runners in the boys race and 3 runners in the girls race. The children were very excited as they had trained hard for the race and were really looking to competing. We all walked the 1/2 mile course first and then the boys' race started. We were overjoyed as we saw 3 yellow shirts emerging from the woods in 2nd, 3rd and 4th places! Then the girls began their race and there were shouts of delight as we saw a yellow shirt run from the trees in 3rd place and then another one in 12th place and another one in 13th place. Our results were added together and it was time for the presentations. We waited anxiously as the positions were read out and we were delighted to hear that our team had come first!

In the afternoon it was the turn of the Y5/6 pupils and they were competing in the annual Harwich and District Schools Sports' Association Cross Country Competition. This is a much larger event, with 10 schools taking part and each school can select 4 runners per team. The race began with everyone walking the 1 mile course first and then the afternoon followed the same order as the morning with the boys running first and then the girls. Our first boy came back in 10 position, followed by one in 14th place, 21st place and in 28th place. Our highest placed girl was in 4th place, then followed by one in 6th position, 14th and then in 18th! Again, there was an anxious time as the all of the points were added together and the presentations began. A huge cheer went up when we heard that our team had come 3rd and was the first of the small schools!

Well done to all of the children who took part - they did exceptionally well and we are very proud of them.
