Every country that joined the war paid a mighty price.

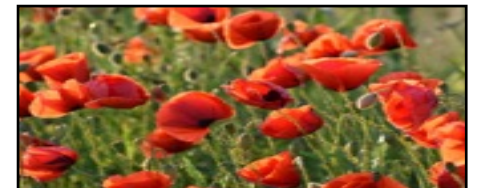
Many people fought for their countries and knew the risk of war, but still charged at their enemies.

Tickets will be sold on a first come basis. Please email the Friends of team with the number of tickets required to secure your places. Please do not send payment without being allocated a ticket first.

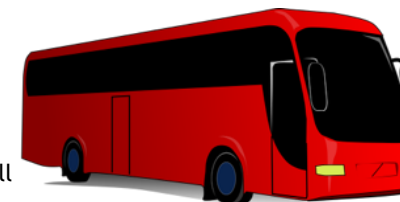
