being allocated a ticket first.

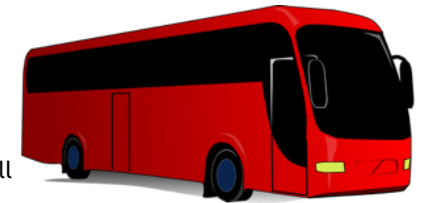
