FOREST SCHOOL REMINDER

As the weather is gradually turning cooler, may I remind you of the need to provide suitable clothing if your child is taking in Forest School sessions over the next half term.

Below is a list of suitable clothing:

*Wellington boots / sturdy trainers which you don't mind getting muddy. These should not be the same trainers that your child wears for PE lessons.

*Warm socks

*All in one suit

*Jogging trousers or tracksuit bottoms

*A fleece or sweatshirt

*A warm waterproof coat - preferably not their school coat as it is likely to get muddy

*Hats and gloves on particularly cold days
